Victor,

I just spoke with Jerry and the reports he got from our on-site producer and other attendees was that Bill did professional job with his presentation and that it was equal in quality to the presentations of many other people who have been on the UFO conference circuit for years.

Not everyone stayed for the whole presentation, but losses are normal at

almost all presentations, and Bill's losses were low. Bill Hamilton showed up on Friday and pooh poohed Serpo, Bill Ryan and UFO Magazine and schmoozed with some Burisch fans, even though he, of course, he is no longer associated with Burisch and has moved on to more profitable endeavors.

The one criticism is that there was too much emphasis on non-bias, and being the messenger and not enough "sizzle." Bill could have used illustration graphics even though actual photos were not available, and he could have told the attendees up front what they came to hear - either the bad ETs (that clone and eat people, as related in the mission log) may be coming to get us and that the good ETs may be planning to

save us, and then at the end of the presentation he could have shown that this story to date doesn't really prove that either premise is valid. And, on it's own it doesn't unless you fold in other events of history that may or may not have happened and lend credence to either the good or bad ET premise or both.

So, the story in of itself lacks that sizzle and personal interest factors (like a discloser that you can either put down as a fraud or worship as the Messiah of the new ET age) that some of the other disclosure stories have. Not Bill's fault or your fault. It is just that the truth sometimes isn't that glamorous or exciting. But, perhaps all the raw, and perhaps scary, truth is yet to come on this story. We shall see.

Jerry did say also that he had a very good interview with Bill Ryan after his presentation, and he thinks the show he will soon put together will be great.
